Saturday, May the 17<sup>th</sup> 1794.

James Brice and Christopher Richmond Esq<sup>r</sup>.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to  
Tobias Butler Sheriff of Frederick County Forty five pounds thirteen  
shillings, for enumerating and returning to this Board a list of the Citizens  
of the said County liable to Militia service.

Monday, May the 19<sup>th</sup> 1794.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and The Hon<sup>ble</sup>  
James Brice, Henry Ridgely, and Christopher Richmond Esq<sup>r</sup>.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John  
Wentz, Printer at Frederick Town Ten pounds two shillings and six pence,  
for printing the naturalization Act, six weeks in his paper.

Tuesday, May the 20<sup>th</sup> 1794.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and  
all the Members.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to  
Henry Whetorst eleven pounds five shillings for making copies of  
the states of the several claims made on the Stock belonging to  
this State, in the Bank of England, to be transmitted to Mr  
Jay, for negotiation.
