

Monday, May the 26th 1794.

The Council met: Present as on the 24th.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel John Haskins Stone forty two pounds three shillings and nine pence for one quarter's pension due the first instant.

On the receipt of a Letter from Benjamin Stoddert Esquire of Montgomery County, informing that his Negro James had unfortunately killed a man, and was confined therefore in the goal of the said County; That the Court in course would not sit until November; & that there will be an adjourned Court on the first Monday in June, and praying that a special commission may issue for the trial of the said Negro James, &c. A special Commission was ordered by the Governor and issued accordingly, directed to William Crick, Thomas Turner, and Benjamin Edwards Esquires.

Tuesday, May the 27th 1794.

A pardon was Ordered by the Governor and issued accordingly to Negro Bob, the slave of Daniel Bowly of Baltimore County.
