

Tuesday June the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1794

The Council met. All the Members present.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas B Randall thirty four pounds, eighteen shillings and one penny <sup>1/2</sup> for enumerating the Citizens in a part of Baltimore County liable to Militia Service, and returning to this Board a List of the Same.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Philip Hall thirty six pounds two shillings and six pence for enumerating &c<sup>a</sup> the remainder of the Citizens of the said County under the direction of Randall.

Friday June 6<sup>th</sup> 1794

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Clark One hundred pounds, on account of the repairs now making under his direction to the Stadt House.

By the Petition of James Baxter of Baltimore County it is set forth that He was presented at January Term 1793 to the Criminal Court of the said County for permitting public gaming in his House; that He was fined ten pounds for the said offence, which He has since paid. That at last March term judgement was obtained by the State against Him, and his securities for six thousand pounds of Tobacco (and Costs) the amount of the Recognizance entered into by the Petitioner on obtaining licence: That He has a family of eight small Children who have no dependence for their support but his daily labour, and that since the State has been satisfied by the payment of the fine, He hopes to be relieved from the payment of the amount of the Recognizance: And The Petitioner case being recommended by three Justices of the said Court, it is hereby

Ordered That the forfeiture on the said Recognizance be remitted
