Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Gouldsmith jun^r six pounds seven shillings and six pence for going express with Letters of appointment to field Officers in the lower Counties on the Western Shore.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Captain John Stewart Twenty pounds for raising out of the Severn River and transporting to Annapolis two eighteen pound pieces of Ordnance, according to an agreement previously made.

Commissions to all Militia Officers under the Rank of a Brigadier General were directed to be dated as on this Day

Tuesday, June the 24th 1794.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Hemming Twelve pounds seven shillings and two pence for going express with Militia appointments.
