

Tuesday, July the 22nd 1794.

The Council met: Present as on the 19th.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Cooper and Patrick Dunn twenty two pounds ten shillings on account of the repairs now making by contract to the Stadt House.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Smith eleven pounds five shillings for repairs now making to the Stadt House.

Marie Francois De Vertices, late of the Island of Saint Domingo appeared and in the presence of the Council took and subscribed the Oath and declaration prescribed by the Act for Naturalization; Wherefore He is become a naturalized Citizen of this State.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Reid One pound ten shillings for hair dressing done for Tho^s Whalley (account paper by the Auditor).
