Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Brice Esquire fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to William Harwood Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due as above.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to William Pittman Esquire One hundred pounds for six months' salary as a Member of the Council, due as above.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Henry Redgely Esquire fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due as above.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Chase Esq^r One hundred and fifty pounds for one quarter's salary due him as Chief Judge of the General Court, due as above.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to John Davidson Esquire fifty pounds, for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due as above.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Anne Sabacher fifteen pounds for one quarter's pension due as above.
