The Council met. Present as yesterday

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Thomas Whalley the sum of seven pounds ten shillings; allowed him by the Governor to bear his expences to Philadelphia on a visit to his friends.

Thursday, August the 14<sup>th</sup> 1794.

The Council met. Present The Hon<sup>ble</sup> William Pakeney  
John Davidson and James Brice Esquires.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Randall Esq<sup>r</sup> Thirty two pounds five shillings and four pence halfpenny for store goods, to Thomas Whalley, as per account approved by the Governor, and passed by the Auditor.

Monday, August the 18<sup>th</sup> 1794.

The Council met. Present as on the 14<sup>th</sup>

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ew Raper Twenty two pounds ten shillings and to Terence Smith fifteen pounds for work done in the repairs now making to the Stadt house.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Col<sup>l</sup> Abrah Forrest sixty seven pounds ten shillings for six months pension due the first instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Col<sup>l</sup> John H Stone forty two pounds three shillings and nine pence for one quarter pension due as above.
