Saturday, September the 13<sup>th</sup> 1794.

The Council met: Present as yesterday.

Thomas McGhee late a British Subject appeared in this council room  
and in presence of the Board repeated and Subscribed the oath and declaration  
prescribed by the naturalization Act: Therefore He is become a Naturalized  
Citizen of this State.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Gray  
Printer in Frederick Town four pounds ten Shillings for printing the Naturalization  
Act.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to John Wilmott twenty eight  
pounds Eighteen Shillings and one pence for riding expens with General Orders  
to Militia Officers (acc<sup>t</sup> paid by the Auditor.)

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Roper and  
Patrick Dunn fifteen pounds, on account of their work in repairing  
Stadt House.

Ordered That the sum of £1000 be given to Col<sup>l</sup> G.
