Whereas by the Petition of James Messer of Somerset
County, accompanied by an official transcript of the Proceedings it
appears that the said Messer was at May term 1793 fined by the Court
of the said County on two several Defaultments in the sum of six pounds each,
for selling liquor without licence; and Whereas the Justices of the said
Court have certified their belief that the said Messer offended entirely
through ignorance of the Law, It is ordered that upon payment of all
legal Costs, the said fines of six pounds each be and they are hereby remitted.
