

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to Mrs Ann Le Vacher, widow of Lieutenant Le Vacher, fifteen pounds, for one quarter's pension due the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to William Paris Eight pounds eighteen shillings and nine pence due him on an account for mending and repairing the State Clocks at the Government House, to this day.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson junior sixty eight pounds and three pence half penny, due on an account allowed by the Governor and passed by the Auditor, for advances of money, and Boon to Miss Grace.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to John Davidson Esquire fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as a member of the Council, due the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Mr William Harwood eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Chase Esquire One hundred and fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as Chief Justice of the General Court due as above.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to John Kelly Sixty two pounds ten shillings for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Council, due as above.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Mr John Shaw thirty seven pounds ten shillings for nine months salary as Attorney, due the 1<sup>st</sup> instant.

On the Petition of Jeremiah Currier of Cecil County of Cecil County setting forth that the Petitioner did on the 17<sup>th</sup> of June become security for a certain Elizabeth Welch of the said County, in a bond to the State of Maryland for the sum of One Hundred and twelve pounds ten shillings, for the purchase money of 200 Acres of Land in New Connaught or Talbot Manor in said County; That the said Elizabeth is since dead and the purchase money and interest still due; That the Petitioner is very poor and entirely unable to pay any part of the said debt, and therefore prays a release from his Securityship, on surrendering to the State's Agent all his right title and interest to the purchase aforesaid: And it being certified by Nath Cransie and Jeremiah Baker Esq<sup>r</sup> of the said County that the facts are in their belief truly stated, It is Ordered that the said Currier be released and the Agent is hereby instructed to release him accordingly from his Securityship, on the conditions above mentioned.
