Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Peter Engels sixty two pounds ten shillings for six months salary as Armorer at Frederick Town, ending the sixth instant, as per Certif^{icate} from the Auditor.

By the Representation of Moses Leconte and John Eccleston Esquires Associate Justices of the Court of Dorchester County, it appears that William Rawley an overseer of the Rodds, was at the last October term of the said Court, convicted and fined for suffering a Tree to remain across the road for some time, to the obstruction of the same; and the said Justices having declared that it appeared to them that the said Rawley was extremely ill, and unable to attend himself to that business, and had given orders on the subject which were not obeyed. It is Ordered that the fine thus incurred by the said Rawley be and the same is (on payment of costs) hereby remitted.
