

Tuesday December the 9th 1794

His Excellency the Governor and the Honble Henry Bridgely Esquire appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Cleland Baker an invalid Officer late of the Maryland Line fifteen pounds for one quarters pension, due the first November last.

Wednesday December 10. 1794

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honble John Davidson, James Price and Henry Bridgely Esquires.

Thursday December the 11th 1794

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honble John Davidson, James Price and William Pitty Esquires.

Friday December the 12th 1794

The Council met. Present the Honble John Davidson, James Price and William Pitty Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Terence Smith Eleven pounds five shillings on account, for work done in the repairs now making to the State House.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Richard Owen one pound two shillings and six pence for a Bayers French Dictionary for the use of the Board.

Monday December 15th 1794
