

Ordered by His Excellency the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Thomas for the use of Joseph Dawson a disabled Soldier late of the Maryland Line Eleven pounds five shillings for three quarters pension due the first of November last. by virtue of a power of attorney from the said Dawson to Captain James Thomas.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Wilmott Seven pounds Eleven shillings for riding express with writs of Election to Montgomery and Frederick Counties. as per Account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to James Cowan printer at Easton thirteen pounds seventeen shillings and Eleven pence being a balance due him on an account passed by the Auditor for printing done for the State.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Doctors Murray and Shaaff five pounds sixteen shillings and three pence due them on account allowed by the late Governor for Medicines furnished to M. Thomas Wally.

Ordered, that Captain Robert Denny be requested to pay out of the Money lodged in his hands by M. Gale Archibald Golders account for provisions furnished by him to Captain Shaffer's guard who brought the Prisoners concerned in the Insurrection in Washington County at Annapolis for Trial and also to repay forty Dollars advanced to Captain Shaffer for the purpose of furnishing his guard with provisions on their return home.
