Tuesday December the 30th 1794

Wednesday December the 31st 1794

The Honble James Brice and Henry Bridgely Esquires appeared in the Council Room.

Thursday January the 1st 1795

His Excellency The Governor attended in the Council Room.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry H. McKearne Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for six months board of Mr. Thomas Wally ending the fifth day of November last and ten shillings for two bottles of Brack furnished the said Wally.

Monday January the 5. 1795.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Members.

Ordered that the act of the last Session of Assembly "to appoint an agent for the year seventeen hundred and Ninety five" be published eight weeks successively in the Annapolis, Easton and Frederick newspapers and the Maryland Journal &c. - and that all Purchasers of confiscated or other property sold by this State who have not heretofore installed their debts be and they are hereby required to install the same with the agents of this State on or before the first day of May next in the manner prescribed by the seventh section of the said act.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order of His Excellency the Governor the sum or sums for which he may draw not exceeding in the whole one hundred and fifty pounds for defraying
