

Saturday January the 31st 1795.

The Council met. Present The Honble James Brice, Henry Bridgely and William Hitty Esquires.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson the sum of Forty five pounds Current Money for six Months half pay ending this day.

Monday February 2nd 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Brice and Henry Bridgely Esquires.

Joshua Stevenson was appointed and Commissioned Inspector of Tobacco for Baltimore County for the ensuing year.

The following persons were appointed Inspectors for Prince Georges County. Viz. Charles Claggett and William Bowie for Upper Marlborough Warehouse. William Lyles and John Macgill for Lucen Anns Warehouse. precisely as last year. Notice thereof sent to the Clerk of the County.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Dorsey Twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence Current Money for three Months half pay as a disabled Officer, due the first Instant

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to His Excellency John H. Stone the sum of forty two pounds three shillings and nine pence Current Money for three Months half pay due him the first instant as a disabled Officer.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to M. Subb Fowler Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's salary as Messenger to the Council &c due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Robert Goldborough Esquire one hundred and twenty five pounds for one quarter's Salary as a Judge of the General Court, due the first instant.
