That the said Treasurer pay to William Harwood, Esquire, the sum of twenty five pounds for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates; due the first instant.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of thirty pounds for six months half pay, due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Davidson, Esquire, thirty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarter's Salary as a Member of Council, due the first instant.
