Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Uriah Forrest thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's pension as a disabled officer due the first instant.

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Brice, and Henry Ridgely, Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M James Angell four pounds seventeen shillings and six pence due on an account papered by the Auditor, for printing done for the State.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to M. Hugh Whiteford two pounds twelve shillings and six pence, in reimbursement of so much paid by him as caution money on a special Warrant of Survey taken out on the fourth day of May seventeen hundred and eighty two; which Warrant is legally proved by the said Whiteford to have been taken for the purpose of being laid on Lands referred by the late Lord Proprietary.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert Denny, Esquire, Fifty pounds for one quarter's salary as Auditor General due the first instant
