

Friday February the 13. 1795.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Brice, Henry Ridgely and William Pitty, Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs Penhney and Guyer the sum of Twenty four pounds four shillings and nine pence due them on an account passed by the Auditor for articles furnished for the use of the House of Delegates.

Ordered that the said Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Pitty, Esquire, Thirty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarter's salary as a member of the Council due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Pitty Esquire the sum of fifty two pounds ten shillings for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Council, due the first instant.

The following persons were reappointed Inspectors for Montgomery County, to wit.

George Beall and Walter Magruder for the Old George Town warehouse.

Charles Magruder and Walter Clagett for the New George Town warehouse.

John Mitchell and George Magruder for the Central Warehouse.
