Ordered that the Clerk of this Board take the necessary measures for the due execution of the Resolution of the General Assembly, which directs the publication of the several Acts of the late Session which contain alterations of the Constitution of this State.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M Tenace Smith the sum of one hundred and twelve pounds twelve shillings on account of plastering work done by him in the repairs now making to the Stadt House.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Edward Profer and Patrick Dunn the sum of thirty pounds current Money on account of Carpenter's Work done by them in the repairs now making to the Stadt House

Friday April the 3rd 1795
