Monday April the 6. 1795

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidfon, James Brice, and Henry Bridgely, Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of Twenty Eight pounds Ten Shillings and four pence current money being the balance due him on an account for articles furnished and services rendered the Public, passed by the Auditor.

Alexander Chesley was Commissioned one of the Inspectors for the new George Town Warehouse in Montgomery County in the Room of Samuel B. Magruder resigned.

The following persons were reappointed Inspectors for Somerset County to act under their Commissions of 1794. George Day Scott for Green Hill Warehouse. Zadick Long for Princess Anne Warehouse. Benjamin Schoolfield for Rehoboth Warehouse. John Horsey, of Smith, for Coulbourn's Creek Warehouse. and James Waters for Maddux's Island. and Notice thereof sent to the Clerk of the County.

Wednesday April the 8. 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Pinkney, John Davidfon, James Brice and Henry Bridgely, Esquire.

John Curtis Handy resigned his Commission as Sheriff of Worcester County, and was thereupon Commissioned Clerk of the said County agreeably to the abovementioned appointment

John Curtis Handy was appointed Clerk of the Court of Worcester County in the Room of James Dr. Morris deceased.

Peter Townsend was Commissioned agreeably to the direction of the form of Government, Sheriff of Worcester County in the Room of
