Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to James Brice, Esquire, Thirty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due as above

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Henry Bridgely, Esquire, the sum of Thirty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Chase, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds Current Money for one quarter's salary as Chief Judge of the General Court, due the first Instant.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Dorsey the sum of Twenty Eight pounds two shillings and six pence Current Money for one quarter's pension, due the first Instant

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Davidson, Esquire, the sum of Thirty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.
