Saturday May the 9th 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Brice and Henry Bridgely, Esquires.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Cleland Baker the sum of Fifteen pounds Current Money for one quarter's pension, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Robert Denny, the sum of Fifty pounds Current Money for one quarter's salary as Auditor General, due the first Instant.

Tuesday May the 12. 1795

The Council met. Present The Honble John Davidson, James Brice and William Mitty, Esquires.

Ordered that The Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Col: Uriah Forrest the sum of Thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Mitty, Esquire, the sum of two pounds two shillings and six pence due him on an account passed by the Auditor for Paper and quills furnished for the use of the Council.

Thomas Plater, Esquire, was appointed an associate Justice for Montgomery County in the Room of Benjamin Edwards, Esquire. Elected a Representative from this State in Congress. and Commission issued accordingly to Thomas Turner and Thomas Plater,
