A Certificate was produced to the Board signed by George Murdoch I. R. Potts, by which it appears that the Securities of M^{rs} Margaret Fisher have secured to the said Margaret Fisher during her life, the annual interest of the balance remaining due on the Bond to the State by the said Margaret Fisher and her said Securities, after payment of the sum of fifteen hundred pounds; and have secured to the Children the principal of the said Balance to be equally divided between them at the death of the said Margaret Fisher pursuant to a Resolution of the General Assembly passed at November Session Seventeen Hundred and Ninety one.

Wednesday May the 13th 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Members.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lazarus Harman, an invalid Soldier late of the Maryland Line the sum of seven pounds ten shillings for six Months pension due the first Instant.

The Board went into the appointment of a Clerk of Charles County Court in the Room of John Beale Turner deceased, to hold the Clerkship until the meeting of the said Court agreeably to the direction of the Constitution when John Barnes was appointed and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Thursday May the 14th 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, Henry Bridgely and William Hilly, Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Peter Engels an un-
der at Frederick Town one hundred and fifty pounds on account
