

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Minian Penhney the sum of Twelve pounds ten shilling Current Money for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Senate due the first Instant.

Samuel Chester of Baltimore County by his Petition sets forth that in November seventeen hundred and Ninety he entered into Recognizance in the sum of fifteen pounds Current Money for the appearance of a certain Joseph Wilkes to answer a presentment and Indictment for Felony, which recognizance through the absconding of the said Wilkes has been declared forfeited, and the Petitioner now under execution for same, all which is confirmed by official documents accompanying the Petition.

The Petitioner represents that he has used his utmost endeavours to bring the said Wilkes to appear and answer the charge against him, and incurred great expence in his attempts for that purpose. He represents that he is very poor and must be ruined if payment of the forfeiture is exacted, all which circumstances, and a recommendation in his behalf from three Justices of the Criminal Court of the said County being duly Considered, it is ordered that the said forfeiture of fifteen pounds incurred as aforesaid by Samuel Chester be and the same is hereby remitted.
