

The Resolution of the Ninth of June Seventeen hundred and Ninety four dividing the State into three divisions for Militia purposes is hereby repealed, and the following arrangement agreed on. To Wit:

The State shall as heretofore be divided into three Divisions. of which
The first shall comprehend the 6th, 5th, 7th and 8th Brigades.
The second the 1st, 5th, 10th and 12th Brigades, and
The third the 2nd, 3rd, 9th and 11th Brigades

Saturday May the 24th 1795

The Honble William Pindney and William Kitty, Esquires, appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Frederick Green Printer to the State the sum of Two hundred and Twenty five pounds, for six Months salary, due the first Instant.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Somerville the sum of Twenty two pounds ten shillings, for one quarter's pension as a disabled Officer, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Winter Printer at Frederick Town the sum of Twenty one pounds fifteen shillings, for Printing done for the State, as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Monday May the 26th 1795

Tuesday May the 27th 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Pindney, John Davidson, James Bruce and William Kitty, Esquires.
