ency John Hoskin Stone the sum of Forty two pounds three Shillings and
nine pence Current Money for three Months half pay, due the first
Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr Henry Shyack the sum
of twenty two pounds nine Shillings Current Money, for enumerating
the persons liable to Militia Service in Washington County.
