Saturday July the 4th 1795

The Council met. Present all the Members.

The Board proceeded to the appointment by Ballot of a Clerk in the Room of John Kelly, Esquire, resigned. The following Gentlemen were in Nomination. Soias Wilson King, Henry Wheteroff, Robert Denny, Minian Pinkney, Thomas Seavings, Thomas Harris and Robert Johnson. On examining the Ballots it appeared that Minian Pinkney had a Majority of Votes. Whereupon it was declared that the said Minian Pinkney was duly appointed Clerk of the Council. Ordered that he have notice and qualify as such.

Howes Goldsborough was appointed one of the Associate Justices of Talbot County Court in the place of William Hayward resigned, and Commission issued accordingly to James Tilghman and Howes Goldsborough Esquires as Associate Justices of the Court of the said County.

John Bordley was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court of Kent County in the place of Andrew Weisenthal resigned, and Commission issued accordingly to Philip Brooks, Robert Anderson and John Bordley, Esquires as Orphans Court Justices of Kent County.

Monday July the 5th 1795
