Ordered by the Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Trueman, the sum of Fifteen pounds current Money, for one quarter's pension, due the first of August last.

Ordered by the Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenant Henry Cleland Baker the sum of Fifteen pounds current Money for one quarter's pension, due the first of August last.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Thomas Walley the sum of Five pounds current Money, it being the balance of one quarter's Salary, due the twenty fourth Instant.
