

Thursday September the 17. 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Brice, Henry Ridgely and William Pitty, Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Harwood, Esquire, the sum of twenty five pounds current Money for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the first of August last.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Mr John Green the sum of five pounds twelve shillings and six pence current Money, for sundry repairs done to the Pump of the Stadd House, as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Henry Ridgely, Esquire, the sum of Thirty seven pounds ten shillings current Money, for one quarter's Salary as a member of the Council, due the first Day of August last.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to His Excellency the Governor the sum of Forty two pounds three shillings and nine pence for three Months half pay, due the first of August last.

Ordered by the Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Richard Dorsey the sum of twenty Eight pounds two shillings and six pence current Money, for one quarter's pension due the first day of August last.

Ordered by the Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenant John Lynn, the sum of fifteen pounds current Money, for three Months half pay, due the first day of August last.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Jones, Esquire, the sum of Fifty pounds current Money, for one quarter's Salary as a Judge of the Court of Appeals, due as above.

It appearing to the Board on the petition of Samuel Mitchel that at April Term seventeen hundred and Ninety five, he was fined on a Submission by the Court of Prince Georges County, for an assault on the body of Elisabeth Lawood, with an intention to Violate her Virtue, the sum of fifty pounds current Money, and it appearing further to the Board by the Certificate of the Judges of the said Court that the property of the said Mitchel is of less value
