The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Members.

The Board proceeded to the appointment of an Examiner General in the Room of William Hanson Esquire, deceased, and upon Examination of the Ballots it appeared that Vachel Stevens Esquire was duly elected.

Friday September the 18<sup>th</sup> 1795

The Council met. Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Davidson Esquire, the sum of Thirty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money for one quarter's Salary as a Member of the Council due the first Day of August last.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Colonel Break Forrest the sum of thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter's half pay due as above.

Vachel Stevens Esquire resigned his Commission as Surveyor of Ann Arundel County, and was thereupon Commissioned Examiner General.

The Board proceeded to the appointment of a Surveyor of Ann Arundel County in the Room of Vachel Stevens Esquire resigned, and upon Examination of the Ballots it appeared that Baruch Fowler was unanimously Elected, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Jacob Cable of Baltimore County having by Petition represented to the Board that he was drafted under the General orders of
