

In consequence of a Requisition from His Excellency Thomas Mifflin, Esquire Governor of the State of Pennsylvania bearing date the 24 of August 1795 the following Warrant was issued.

The State of Maryland To the Sheriff of Harford County. Greeting.

Whereas a certain John Montgomery, Esquire Attorney at Law late of Harford County in this State stands indicted at a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held in and for Mifflin County in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by the Name of John Montgomery the younger Esquire Attorney at Law late of the said County of Mifflin for that he the said John Montgomery on the sixteenth day of December in the Year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety one, at Lewis Town, in the County aforesaid, and within the Jurisdiction of this Court with Force and Arms and so forth, in and upon Thomas Smith, Esquire, President of the Court of Common Pleas of the Fourth Circuit consisting of the Counties of Cumberland, Franklin, Bedford, Huntington and the said County of Mifflin, in the peace of God, and the Commonwealth then and there being, an Assault did make and him the said Thomas Smith then and there did beat, wound and ill Treat the said Assault and Battery being committed by the said John Montgomery on the said Thomas Smith in consequence of the Conduct of the said Thomas Smith in the Execution of his Office of President aforesaid in the Court of Common Pleas aforesaid of the County of Mifflin aforesaid on the sixteenth day of December in the Year last mentioned, aforesaid and other Harms to the said Thomas Smith, then and there did to the great Damage of the said Thomas Smith and against the peace Dignity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as appears by an official Copy of the Indictment found by the Grand Jurors for the Body of the said County of Mifflin against the said John Montgomery duly authenticated and to us transmitted. and Whereas it is represented to us by His Excellency Thomas Mifflin Governor of the said State of Pennsylvania that the said John Montgomery has fled from the said State from Justice and is now residing in Harford County in this State, and the
