

Tuesday September the 29. 1795

The Honble Henry Bridgely Esquire, appeared in the Council Room.

Wednesday September the 30. 1795.

His Excellency the Governor attended in the Council Room.

Thursday October the 1st 1795.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Brice and Henry Bridgely Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Rumsey Esquire, the sum of fifty pounds current Money for one quarter's Salary as Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, due the first of August last.

The Board proceeded to the appointment of a Surveyor of Montgomery County in the place of Archibald Orme, Esquire, resigned and upon Examination of the Ballots it appeared that Thomas Orme was unanimously elected and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Friday October the 2nd 1795.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable John Davidson, James Brice and Henry Bridgely Esquires.

Richard Beswick was appointed an Commissioned Inspector of Tobacco at Emersons Warehouse in Talbot County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Frederick Green Printer to the State, the sum of Forty six pounds thirteen shillings current Money, for publishing the Laws in alteration of the Constitution and Form of Government, as per Account passed by the Auditor.

Daniel Dorsey was appointed and Commissioned one of the Coroners of Frederick County.

Friday October the 9th 1795.

The Council met. Present The Honble William Pinkney, John Davidson and Henry Bridgely Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Peter Engells Armourer at Frederick Town, the sum of one hundred and forty six pounds thirteen shillings current Money, for five months Salary and work done per Account passed by the Auditor.
