

Monday October the 19th 1795

His Excellency The Governor and The Honble John Davidson and James Brice appeared in the Council Room.

Tuesday October 20th 1795

His Excellency The Governor and The Honble William Pinkney, John Davidson and William Hilly, Esquires, appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Abraham Gambell an invalid Soldier late of the Maryland line six pounds fifteen shillings for nine months pension due the first Day of August last, agreeably to a Resolution of the General Assembly passed at November Session Seventeen Hundred and Ninety One.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Matthias Bartgis Printer at Frederick Town, the sum of four pounds ten shillings current Money for publishing in his Paper the Act of Naturalization three Weeks as per Account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Henry Carbury Esquire, the sum of seven pounds ten shillings current Money, on an Account passed by the Auditor for blank Returns furnished to the Commanding Officers of the Militia agreeable to the order of the Governor.

Wednesday October the 21st 1795

Thursday October the 22nd 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble John Davidson, James Brice, and William Hilly, Esquires.

Archibald Robinson was appointed Coroner for Harford County in the Room of Bennett Busby resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.
