The Board on Consideration of all Circumstances and from the Recommendation of the Court in Behalf of the said Petitioner do Order that the said John Gadhue be discharged from the above Fine on the payment of one pound five shillings and Costs of Suit.

In Consequence of a Requisition from His Excellency Robert Brooke Esquire, Governor of the State of Virginia bearing date 17th October 1795. the following Warrant was issued.

The State of Maryland To the Sheriff of Frederick County Greeting.

Whereas a certain Matthew Gording alias Goodwin is charged with the Crime of Horse Stealing by the affidavits of John Thompson and Nathaniel Curtis inhabitants of Virginia, authentic Copies of which affidavits have been transmitted to us by the Governor of Virginia. And Whereas it is represented by His Excellency Robert Brooke Governor of the said State of Virginia that the said Matthew Gording alias Goodwin has fled from the said State from Justice and is now residing in Frederick County in this State, and the said Robert Brooke Esquire hath in pursuance of the Constitution of the United States and the Act of Congress entitled "An Act respecting Fugitives from Justice and persons escaping from the Service of their Masters" demanded of us that the said Matthew Gording alias Goodwin be arrested and secured so that he may be delivered up to such person as may be appointed by the Executive of the said State of Virginia to be removed to the said State having Jurisdiction of the Crime wherewith he is charged.
