By a Transcript from the proceedings of Washington County Court it appears that a certain William Beckwith of the said County was by the said Court at December Term seventeen hundred and Ninety three fined on four several presentments in the quantity of six hundred pounds of Tobacco each for selling Spiritous Liquors without Licence. To which Transcript is annexed a Recommendation from the two Associate Justices of the said Court for a Remission of the said Fines on account of the Poverty and the numerous Family of the Petitioner. The Board on consideration of the Circumstances of the Case do order and direct that the said fines be and they are hereby remitted on payment of Costs.
