The Council met Present The Honble William Pinkney, John David-  
son, James Bruce and Henry Bridgely, Esquires.

The Board proceeded to the appointment of an Armourer at Frederick Town in  
the room of Peter Engells resigned, when Captain Nicholas White was appo-  
inted, and have agreed to allow him the same Salary which Mr Engells received.

Ordered that Captain Nicholas White Armourer at Frederick Town, send  
down to this place six Barrels of powder two of which are requested to be  
of the best Quality in the Magazine.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Robert Ipble  
the sum of two pounds twelve shillings Current Money, for going Express to  
Baltimore with Despatches to the Collector of the Customs, as per Account  
passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr William Tuck the sum of Ten  
pounds thirteen shillings and three pence Current Money for cleaning  
the Windows in the House of Delegates Senate and the Hall of the State  
House as per Account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr John Shaw the sum  
of seven pounds ten shillings Current Money for the purpose of pur-  
chasing necessaries for the General Assembly.
