

Monday November 2. 1795

His Excellency The Governor appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered by His Excellency The Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Trueman, the sum of Fifteen pounds Current Money for one quarter's half pay due the first Instant.

Tuesday November 3rd 1795

His Excellency The Governor and The Honble James Brice and Henry Ridgely, Esquires appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to His Excellency John Hoshins Stone, the sum of Forty two pounds three shillings and Nine pence Current Money, for three Months half pay due, the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to James Brice, Esquire, the sum of Thirty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due the first Instant.

Ordered by the Governor that the said Treasurer pay to Captain James Somervell the sum of Forty five pounds Current Money, for six Months half pay due, as above.

Wednesday November 4. 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble James Brice, Henry Ridgely and William Kitty, Esquires.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson the sum of sixty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money, for nine Months half pay due, the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to William Kitty, Esquire, the sum of Thirty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money, for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Henry Ridgely, Esquire, the sum of Thirty seven pounds ten shillings Current Money, for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council, due the first Instant.
