

Minian Pinkney was appointed Clerk of the Council and immediately qualified as such before Henry Bridgely Esquire one of the Aldermen of the City of Annapolis by taking repeating and subscribing the several oaths and the declaration prescribed by law for that purpose.

Subb Fowler was reappointed Messenger to the Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Mac: hall Esquire the Sum of one hundred pounds Current Money for six months salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Benjamin Crumsey Esq. the Sum of Fifty pounds Current Money for one quarters salary as Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Jones Esquire the Sum of fifty pounds Current Money for one quarters salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr Subb Fowler the Sum of eighteen pounds fifteen shillings Current Money for one quarters salary as Messenger to the Council due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mess^{rs} Pinkney and Guyer the Sum of eleven pounds nine shillings and nine pence Current Money due them on an account passed by the Auditor for articles furnished for the use of the Council.

By a representation from the Court of Queen Anns County it appears that a certain James Gilbert of the said County entered into a Recognizance at Term seventeen hundred and Ninety in the Sum of twenty pounds Current Money for his appearance at Court for an assault and Battery on a certain Charles Clark of the said County committed. which Recognizance was forfeited whilst the said James Gilbert was on the Western expedition against the Insurgents. The Court likewise represents that the said James Gilbert is poor. all which circumstances being duly considered it is ordered that the said Forfeiture of twenty pounds be and the same is hereby remitted
