

Thursday November 19th 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Brice, Henry Ridgely, William Hilly and James Thomas Esq^r. John Montgomery Esquire agreeably to the order of the day appeared with his Counsel at the Bar, and after some time occupied in argument the Board adjourned, having at the request of the said Montgomery postponed the case for further argument on to Morrow.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lazarus Harmon an invalid Soldier late of the Maryland Line the sum of seven pounds ten shillings for six months pension due the first instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Robert Denny the sum of Fifty pounds current Money for one quarter's salary, as Auditor General, due the first instant.

Monday November 23rd 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Brice, Henry Ridgely, William Hilly and James Thomas Esquires.

Tuesday November 24th 1795

His Excellency the Governor and The Honble William Hilly and James Thomas Esquires appeared in the Council Room.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of fifteen pounds current Money for three months half pay due the first instant.
