His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Thomas Esquire appeared in the Council Room.

Monday November 30. 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Price, Henry Bridgely, William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Uriah Forrest the sum of thirty three pounds fifteen shillings current Money for one quarters half pay due the first instant.

Tuesday (December 1st 1795

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Price, Henry Bridgely, William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

John Davidson Esquire a Counsellor elect appeared in the Council Room, and was qualified before Allen Luyon Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for Ann Arundel County, by taking repeating and subscribing the feveral oaths and the declaration prescribed by the Constitutions and Laws of this State and the United States.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Anderson the sum of sixty seven pounds ten shillings current Money for nine months half pay due the first day of last Month.

Wednesday (December 2. 1795.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble James Price Henry Bridgely John Davidson William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Davidson Esquire the sum of thirty seven pounds ten shillings current Money for one quarters Salary as a member of the Council, due the first day of last Month.

Thursday December 3. 1795.

Friday December 4th 1795
