

Monday February the 1. 1796

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Henry Ridgely, William Hilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Jones, Esquire, the sum of Fifty pounds current Money for one quarters salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due this day.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Henry Ridgely Esquire the sum of thirty seven pounds ten shillings current Money for one quarters salary as a member of the Council due this day.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Chase, Esquire, the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds current Money for one quarters salary as Chief Judge of the General Court due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Minian Pinkney the sum of Eighty one pounds twelve shillings and six pence current Money for one quarters and twenty eight days salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Minian Pinkney the sum of twelve pounds ten shillings current Money for one quarters salary as Chief Clerk of the Senate due the first day of November last.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Robert Denny the sum of fifty pounds current Money for one quarters salary as Auditor General due this day.

A new Commission issued including Jesse Bourne junior as a Justice of the Peace for Calvert County left out in the old one through mistake. Note the above person follows Walter Mackall.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Subb Fowler, the sum of Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings current Money, for one quarters salary as messenger to the Council; due this day.

Tuesday February the 2. 1796

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Henry Ridgely, William Hilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr anno Lebacker the sum of fifteen pounds current Money for one quarters half pay due the first instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Hilty Esquire the sum of thirty seven pounds ten shillings current Money for one quarters salary as a member of the Council; due as above.
