

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Chase Esquire late Chief Judge of the State of Maryland the sum of twenty five pounds current money, it being so much due him on account of his salary as Chief Judge aforesaid up to the fifteenth of February seventeen hundred and Ninety six the time of his Resignation of his office of Chief Judge aforesaid.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Casign Schu Bowen the sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings current money for six months half pay, due the first day of February last.

The Board having received a letter from Gabriel Duvall Esquire dated the twenty seventh day of March last notifying his Resignation of his seat in the Congress of the United States: ordered, that writs be issued to the Sheriffs of Anne Arundel and Prince Georges Counties, and to the Mayor Recorder and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis or any three of them, requiring them to hold an Election on the Eighteenth Instant at the usual places for holding Elections for Members of the House of Delegates in this State, after having given at least eleven days notice (exclusive of the day of notice) for a person to represent this State in the Congress of the United States in the room of the said Gabriel Duvall Esquire. The following writs issued accordingly.

The State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County Greeting. Whereas by the resignation of Gabriel Duvall Esquire signified by a letter dated the twenty seventh day of March last a vacancy has arisen in the representation of this State in the House of Representatives of the United States, which vacancy (according to an act of assembly passed at November session seventeen hundred and Ninety entitled "an act directing the times places and manner of holding Elections for Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States and for appointing Electors on the part of this State for choosing a President and Vice President of the United States and for the regulation of the said Elections and also to repeal the act of assembly therein mentioned" and according to another act of assembly supplementary to the act aforesaid passed at November session seventeen hundred and Ninety one must be filled by a Person resident within, and elected by the qualified Voters of the third District of this State as designated by the said acts of assembly. We do therefore in pursuance of the powers vested in us by the acts aforesaid, hereby authorize and Command you to hold an Election for a person to represent this State
