The Petitioner represents that he is willing to have the presentment tried and will pay the fine and all Costs provided the said Collins shall be found guilty, on this ground he prays to be discharged from the forfeiture aforesaid. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and a recommendation of two of the associate Justices do order and direct that he be discharged from the aforesaid forfeiture on payment of Costs of Suit.

William McComas of Harford County by his Petition accompanied by an official Transcript of the proceedings therein referred to sets forth that at March Term last of the Court of the said County he was fined the quantity of six hundred pounds of Tobacco and Costs of Suit for keeping ordinary without Licence. that he was led into a breach of the Law in this respect by a reliance on the late Sheriff of Harford County who had informed him that a personal application for a Licence was not necessary and that he would procure a Licence for him. the said Sheriff afterwards informed him that he had procured him a Licence and in consequence of this information he declined receiving Money due to him from the said Sheriff and left it in his Hands to reimburse him for sum already have been paid by him for the Licence. - that depending upon the
