Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the legal representative of Mr. Henry Worfield late Clerk of the Senate the sum of twelve pounds ten shillings current Money for one quarter's salary due the first day of February last

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Anderson the sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings current Money for three months half pay due the first day of February last.

Thursday April the 14. 1796

The Council met. Present The Honble James Brice, Henry Bridgely and James Thomas Esquires

By the Petition of William Baker and Benjamin Towland of Harford County it appears that at March Term seventeen hundred and Ninety three they entered into a Recognizance in the sum of five pounds before the Court of the said County for the appearance of the said William Baker which Recognizance was respited to August Term seventeen hundred and Ninety three at which Term the said William Baker appeared according to the said Recognizance but the said appearance was neglected to be recorded by the Clerk and the said Recognizance was declared to be forfeited. - that a Capias ad respondendum issued out of Harford County Court against the Petitioners returnable to March Term seventeen hundred and Ninety six upon which they were arrested but on the return of said writ by reason of the appearance not being entered the Petitioners were precluded from taking advantage thereof. They therefore pray to be released from the said Forfeiture. on consideration of which circumstances and from a Recommendation in their behalf from the Court of the said County it is ordered and directed that the said William Baker and Benjamin Towland be released from the forfeiture aforesaid.
