The Board having received a letter from Valentine Brooker of Frederick Town expressing his consent to act under the Resolution of the last session of a assembly respecting the sale of Powder arms and accoutrements and having previously determined what part thereof should be sold after retaining such as they deemed necessary for the use of the State. The following directions to the said Valentine Brooker were agreed on.

1st That the said Valentine Brooker do sell and dispose of a part of the said Powder arms and accoutrements agreeable to the following list viz

- 139 Half barrels of Gun Powder
- 79 Quarter Casks do
- 1 Tierce do
- 682 Stands of arms returned by the armourer unfit for use
- 590 Bayonets
- 225 damaged Belts
- 421 do Gun Slings
- 212 Musket Barrels
- 190 Musket Locks
- 1 Box old Gun mounting
- 9 Casks of Brimstone
- 333 loose Tents
- 32 damaged do

2nd That the Powder and Brimstone be sold by the said Valentine Brooker at Baltimore Town and that the said Valentine Brooker take measures for transporting those articles there as soon as possible and furnishing Casks if necessary for which purpose an order is drawn on the Treasurer and transmitted herewith for the sum of Fifty pounds Current Money to be accounted for as the said Resolution directs

3rd That one weeks previous notice be given in two of the Baltimore daily Papers of the time and Terms of the said sale.
