The petitioner further represents that at November Term following the said Elisabeth Achle did attend the said Court and was sworn to the Grand Jury but no Bill was found. He further represents that he is now under execution that he has a wife and small children depending upon him for support. The Board on consideration of all which circumstances and from a recommendation from three of the Justices of the said Court do order and direct that the said John Achle be released from the forfeiture aforesaid.
