The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Henry Bridgely William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

By a representation from the Chief and two Associate Justices of Washington County Court it appears, that John McCoy of the said County was at April Term last of the Court of the said County fined on five several presentments the sum of six pounds Current Money each for selling spiritous Liquors without License. The said Court represent that the said John McCoy had prior to the presentments made by the Grand Jury made application to Nathaniel Procheester late an Associate Justice for a permit to sell spiritous Liquors, that he could not obtain the said License the said Procheester having a short time before given up his appointment as Associate Justice, that the said McCoy from all the circumstances appeared to be desirous to conform to the law. They further state that he is very poor with a large and helpless family and if compelled to pay the fines imposed on him will be reduced to great distress. They therefore recommend that the said Fines or a part thereof be remitted. The Board on consideration of which circumstances do order and direct that the said John McCoy be released from the above Fines on payment of Costs of Suits.
