Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Francis Hamusly late Sheriff of Saint Marys County the sum of fifteen pounds seventeen shillings and six pence current money for three years services under the act of assembly entitled a supplement to an act for the speedy conveyance of public letters and packets and for other purposes commencing October seventeen hundred and Ninety one and ending October seventeen hundred and Ninety four as per account passed by the Auditor.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Henry Ridgely William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Nicholas White armorer at Frederick Town the sum of fifty five pounds current money for repairs made to the arms as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Nicholas White the sum of thirty one pounds five shillings current money for one quarters salary as armorer at Frederick Town due the first instant.

Upton Bruce was appointed and commissioned Coroner for Frederick County.

John McComas of Daniel was appointed one of the Coroners for Harford County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Barton Tabbs was appointed one of the associate Justices of Saint Marys County in the room of John Debutts deceased and Commission issued accordingly to William Kilgour and Barton Tabbs as associate Justices of the said County.

By a Transcript from the Proceedings of Ounie Georges County Court it appears that a certain William Lenkins of the said County entered into a recognizance in the sum of twenty pounds current money at September Term seventeen hundred and Ninety two for the appearance of a certain Thomas Conner to answer a presentment for detaining and marking a sow. that the Court have respited his Recognizance from Term to Term
