The Petitioner represents that a short time after his entering into the said recognizance and before the meeting of the said Court it became necessary for the said Farrell to leave Baltimore for the benefit of his health and is informed and believes that the said John Farrell departed this life between Baltimore and Bath where he was going for the benefit of his health. in consequence of which it became impossible to deliver up the said John Farrell agreeable to the Tenor of his recognizance which was therefore at the said Term declared to be forfeited. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from a recommendation of the Court in his behalf do order and direct that the said Elkin Solomon be released from the aforesaid Forfeiture on payment of costs of suit.
