Monday May the 23. 1796

The Council met. Present The Honble Henry Ridgely, John Davidson, William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

Sutton Isaac Weems was appointed and Commissioned Coroner for Calvert County.

The Board received enclosed from General Bayley Valentine Brothers Bond to the State with Philip Thomas and John Grahame his securities conditioned for the faithful discharge of his Duties under the Resolution of the General Assembly respecting the sale of the public arms and forth ordered that the Clerk of the Council deliver the said Bond to the Auditor which was done accordingly.

Tuesday May the 24. 1796

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Henry Ridgely, John Davidson, William Kilty and James Thomas Esquires.

William Webb Haddaway was appointed and Commissioned one of the Coroners for Talbot County in the room of Lambden deceased. Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Brigadier General Mountjoy Bayley or his order the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds current Money to be applied towards the repairs of the Magazine at Frederick Town which are now making under his directions by order of the Executive and to be by him accounted for.
